

12 January 1746 the local courts heard a "presentment that John Birkbeck and others of Hartley did by hushing for lead ore in a place called Harnagill in the parish of K. Stephen in such manner poison and pollute the streams of water in Hartley Town Beck and Eden that the said streams became unwholesome and corrupt so that those who had lands adjoining to the streams and cattle were hurt and greatly damaged thereby. On 7 April, 1755, John Longstaff was indicted for the same offence and fined one shilling."

Appleby Christmas Session 1779 Removal order Jonathan Birkbeck miner, wife Jane and children Jonathan 6, Ann 4 and Sarah 1, to go from Winton to Kirkby Stephen. Confirmed on appeal subject to the opinion of the court of King's Bench.
